Why aren't residents in Bridgnorth and Oswestry receiving a food waste service?

At present we don't have the facilities to deal with collecting food waste from residents in Bridgnorth and Oswestry. A service will be introduced soon.

Where can I order caddy liners from?

Will the food in my caddy smell?

All food waste can be scraped straight into your caddy. Putting a small amount of newspaper at the bottom of the caddy will absorb any smells or moisture. This newspaper can be thrown into the garden waste along with your food waste. Storing food in the caddy is just the same as placing it in your normal rubbish bin.

Can I use plastic bags to line my caddy?

What can I put in my food caddy?

You can put in eggs, dairy products, fruit and vegetables, meat, fish, bones, tea bags, ground coffee, bread, pasta, rice and plate scrapings, including gravy.

Please don't put any liquids including milk, cooking oil or cooking grease in it - these should be put in the residual waste.

Food packaging, including cling film, plastic trays or paper, must not be put in your caddy either.
