#### Questions from Andy Stelman

The Crowther report contains 47 recommendations. But there are three compelling issues in the text that are not covered by any recommendation. They are: inaction because of fear of being labelled as racist; treating the victim as an offender or as contributing to their own victimhood by their behaviour; and the particular vulnerability of looked after children. How is the Council going to deal with those issues?

As the the Leader of Shropshire Council said in her statement on 20.7.22, “We are reviewing all 47 recommendations and will apply all those that improve practice here”. Exactly which recommendations will be acted on and how?
