Harm to Children

The rugby club and grounds are adjacent to Linney playing field and playground which is well used by families with young children. Teenagers also use this space to congregate and play football. This area is well used all year round. This application could discourage outdoor play for many.

Prevent Public Nuisance

The rugby club and field back onto residential properties. In the licensing application it states that 'noise is to be kept at a level that cannot be heard inside local residences when their windows are closed'. During the summer months most residents enjoy their gardens well into the evening and certainly need to sleep with windows open during hot weather. Loud music before and after 11pm would destroy our environment which is in a conservation area.

Prevent Crime and Disorder

No mention on licensing application of prevention of crime and disorder OUTSIDE the venue. Extra policing would most certainly be required outside the venue, who would pay for this?

Public Safety

The application only refers to protocols inside the venue, what about disturbance late night revellers will have on neighbouring properties by both traffic noise and people leaving the venue. Also many walkers and dog walkers use the Linney which is a lane with lots of bends restricting two way traffic, cars often go onto the pavement to pass.
