The term "vicinity" is used in the Licensing Act 2003, in particular with reference to those "interested parties" who may lodge objections to review applications and who may make representations concerning existing premises licences. The Act defines "interested parties" as being "a person living in the vicinity, a body representing persons living in the vicinity, a person involved in a business in the vicinity or a body representing those persons". However, the Act does not define the term "vicinity"

The Licensing Authority has decided that in order to assist applicants and residents it would be helpful to provide guidance as to how it will approach the meaning of the term "vicinity". The Licensing Authority will normally treat the term "vicinity" as meaning within a 100 metre radius of the premises in question. However it is open to an applicant to argue that in particular instances, an objection from an "interested party" within this radius is not relevant. For example, where a major route lies between the resident and the premises and noise from the premises is highly unlikely to affect the resident. It is also open to an "interested party" located outside of this radius to argue that a representation is valid, for example where the resident lives on the route from the premises to bus stops, car parks etc.

TO PREVENT PUBLIC NUISANCE THIS PROPOSED EVENTS VENUE SUROUNDING RESIDENTIAL AREA IS POOLYLIT. SOME INDIVIDUALS DO NOT ALWAYS BEHAVE WELL WHEN THEY CANNOT BE EASILY SEEN, CAUSING DAMAKE TO THEMSELUES, OTHERS AND PROPERTY, ESPECIALLY WHEN UNDER THE INFLUENCE OF ALCOHOL AND ILLEAGAL DRUGS. THIS ASPECT NEEDS NO BE INVESTIGATED BEFORE THIS APPLICATION IS CONCIDERED. I SUGGEST THAT A "CALLIN" IS MADE TO THE AREA BY THE LICENSON COMMITTE ASAP.

TO PREVENT CRIME & DISORDER "SIMPLE", DO NOT APPROVE THIS LICENCE APPLICATION AS IT STANDS. ONGSING' CONCIDER THENDIS RUPTION & DANGERS THIS LICENCE IF APPROVED WILL CAUSE TO THE RESIDENTS OF THIS AREA THROUGHOUT THE YEAR SUGGEST THE FESTIVAL ORGANISSAS RE NEGOTIATE WITH THE LUDLOW CASTLE COMMITTEE. THIS ACTION WILL HAVE THE SUPPORT OF THE LOCAL RESIDENTS.

PUBLIC SAFETY CLOSE TO THE RUGBY FIELDS IS A WIDE RAST FLOWING RIVER WITH LOW RIVER BANKSTHAT CAN BE EASILY REACHED. THERE IS ONLY ONE ENTRANCE AND EXIT TO THE CLUB, THIS IS ONLY 13 FEET WIDE AND WILL HAUZ TO ACCOMODATE SIX THOUSAND PEOPLE OVER 3 DAYS, DELIUSRY VEHICLES AND EMERCISHCY VEHICLES. THE ROAD OUTSIDE IS ALSO ONLY 13 FEET WIDE, LESS 6 FEET ALLOCATED FOR PARLLING PERHIT HOLDERS.

No new evidence can be introduced at the hearing. It is therefore imperative that you detail all matters that you wish to be considered on this initial representation.
