THE PREVENTION OF HARM TO CHILDREN

The Rugby Club is situated adjacent to the Linney Playground, which is in constant use by children of all ages. It is also likely that the Council car park will be filled by visitors to the Rugby Club and prevent its use by parents and children who just want to use the play ground.

TO PREVENT PUBLIC NUISANCE

The holding of events outside of the clubhouse will lead to a major public nuisance and the playing of music until the early hours will ruin the peace of local residents and disturb the ability to sleep.
The access to the Rugby Club is via narrow roads, often where two cars cannot pass each other, it is totally unsuitable for high volumes of traffic or large vehicles.

TO PREVENT CRIME & DISORDER

Low level crime and disorder is already not uncommon and seems associated with late night activity down by the river and play area. It is likely that people leaving the Rugby Club late at night will be worse for wear and some will add to the problem.

PUBLIC SAFETY

The pavements in the Linney, where they exist at all, are narrow and poorly lit and it is not unusual for cars to mount them, particularly when they encounter a vehicle travelling in the opposite direction. The increase in traffic will only serve to increase greatly the danger to the public.
