THE PREVENTION OF HARM TO CHILDREN

The Tennis Club is busy with children, particularly on a Saturday when group coaching takes place. The Tennis Club is bordering the Rugby Club and also the Public Play ground a football field is very busy in the summer and adjoins the R.C.

TO PREVENT PUBLIC NUISANCE

We already have large crowds for Rugby, cycling functions, weddings and other public events which can cause a nuisance when visitors park in our Tennis Club Car Park, and tennis members have nowhere to go.

TO PREVENT CRIME & DISORDER

I object to excessive hours of drinking as it has led to damage of parked cars in the hinney, and also excessive noise late at night which travels very clearly, especially in the summer.

PUBLIC SAFETY

The Rugby Club is only accessible via the hinney & Dinham lanes which are very narrow and awkward with sharp, blind corners, which are totally unsuitable for caravans, vans & coaches, or large number of cars. It is a quiet residential area and I feel unsafe walking around it, especially with grandchildren or a dog.

I would like the Castle to review their conditions of the Spring Festival to keep it in the centre of Ludlow. I would recommend the Rugby Club retains its licence as it is and not exceed the present functions. It is a sports club.
