TO PREVENT PUBLIC NUISANCE

The effect of noise and road traffic on residents is likely to be very great. One event that is planned is the Ludlow Spring Festival with 5000 to 6000 people. Future events could include Rock Festival, Folk Festival, Jazz Festival, Beer Festival and so on. Shouting and cheering can be heard within and closed windows in Upper Linsey when a Rugby Match is in progress. Clearly Tannoy announcements and amplified music will be of a different order and could continue into the night. With say 10 coaches and 600 cars arriving and leaving the Linsey and Dinham will be impassable to residents in one direction or the other for large parts of the day. Even the better road via Whitcliffe has parts where two vehicles have difficulty passing.
