THE LINNEY IS A VERY NARROW ROAD MAKING IT DIFFICULT FOR 2 CARS TO PASS. NECESSITATING MOUNTING THE PAVEMENT IN PLACES. IT IS NOT SUITABLE OR SAFE FOR HEAVY TRAFFIC. THERE HAVE BEEN RECENT LATE NIGHT ACCIDENTS PARTLY DUE TO INCREASED TRAFFIC
