TO PREVENT CRIME & DISORDER

* ALCOHOL CONSUMPTION BY LARGE NUMBERS (THE SPRING FESTIVAL HAS APPROX 6000 ATTENDEES PER DAY OVER 4 DAYS). RISKS OF INAPPROPRIATE BEHAVIOUR, PARTICULARLY LATE AT NIGHT.

PUBLIC SAFETY

INCREASED TRAFFIC IN THE WUNNEY WOULD HAVE A HUGE IMPACT ON SAFETY. IN THE COLD SNAP BEFORE CHRISTMAS, A CAR EMBEDDED ITSELF IN THE FRONT WALL OF OUR PROPERTY. IF HAD ANYONE BEEN ON THE PAVEMENT, THERE WOULD HAVE BEEN AT LEAST, A SERIOUS INJURY, POSSIBLY WORSE.
