

Hello Licencing Team,

I am making a representation (other) against the licence application by Ludlow Rugby Football Club, Linney, Ludlow SY8 1EE as follows:-

**TO PREVENT PUBLIC NUISANCE**

1. Volumes. The volumes of people mentioned in the application are not compatible with access to the site. The site is served by what is effectively a single-track road. The "Storm the Castle" event attracting five hundred people (one tenth of the proposed number), resulted in road closures. The proposed events would prevent the residents of the Linney and Dinham from leaving their houses for the duration of the proposed events. Gridlock would result.
2. Extended Hours. The Rubgy Club is close to houses in the Linney and Dinham. Wednesday evening practice is heard inside nearby houses with the windows closed. The proposal to extend the hours to 01:00 hours would create a nuisance.

**PUBLIC SAFETY**

1. The site is not compatible with the proposed number of people. It is inevitable it would create a public safety issue. How would an ambulance go to or leave the site when the same single-track road is used for access by those attending site.

The application proposes a number of risk assessments; they must be produced before the further consideration of any application.
