THE PREVENTION OF HARM TO CHILDREN THERE IS A POPULAR PLANGROUND FOR CHILDREN OF ALL AGES NEXT TO THE CLUB, PLUS A FOOTBALL PITCH FOR TEENAGERS. YOUNG PEOPLE COULD BE AFFECTED BY INCREASED DRUNKEN BEHAVIOUR NEARBY AND BY LESS CONTROLLED ACCESS TO ALLOHOL. HOURS OF OPEN AIR AND LAYDOOR DRINKING NEED TO BE CONTROLLED TO PROTECT THEM SOTHEY CAN ENJOY THEMSELVES SAFELY.

TO PREVENT PUBLIC NUISANCE UPPER LINNEY IS A NARROW STREET ON THE WAY DOWN FROM THE TOWN CENTRE. FRONT DEORS OPEN STRAIGHT ONTO IT. DRUNKEN BEHAVIOUR AFFECTS US, AS DOES LIGHT POLLUTION FROM THE BACK. AMPLIFIED MUSIC PENETRATES EVEN SHUT WINDOWS, AND WE NEED THEM OFEN, AND THE RIVER VALLEY ACCOUSTICS THROW SOUND UP INTO OUR HOUSES CAUSING SLEEPLESSNESS. IT IS NOT A SUITABLE VENUE FOR PARTYING BEHOURS LONG PAST WHAT IS NOW IN PLACE. INCRESED TRAFFIC INCREASES NOISE AND NUISANCE.

TO PREVENT CRIME & DISORDER

PEOPLE GOING PAST DRUNK LATE TEND TO THROW THINGS ABOUT, SHOUT, OR OPPORTUNISTICALLY DAMAGE PARKED CARS OR BREAK INTO GATES AND PROPERTY EN ROUTE. OUR PARTICULAR STREET IS NOT WELL LIT AND PAVEMENTS ARE MINIMAL. THE LICENCING HOURS ARE ABLE TO CONTAIN TROUBLE, BUT TO INCREASE THEM WOULD CHANGE THAT.

PUBLIC SAFETY

SEE ABOVE. ALSO, DRIVERS UNFAMILIAR WITH OUR NARROW ROADS AND SHARP BENDS ALREADY HAVE ACCIDENTS; & WHERE LINNEY AND UPPER LINNEY JOIN. LATE NIGHT DRINKING AND INCREASED DRINKING WOULD MAKE IT WORSE,
