<b>TO PREVENT PUBLIC NUISANCE</b>  The site is in the centre of the Ludlow Conservation Area, is adjacent to the Teme SSSI with its nationally important wildlife, geology and fauna, and close to residential streets. To have noise and associated disturbance from outside activities late into the night and early hours is inappropriate. Furthermore I am concerned that the terms of the license will extend to the use of the premises by other bodies for use by gatherings not related to Rugby, and thereby permit the holding of parties, receptions, concerts and similar activities, the noise and disturbance from which is inappropriate and unacceptable for the location.
