The Lunney Playing Fields are next to the Ludlow Rugby club. With a lot more people around and a lot more alcohol available, so close by, will inevitably impinge on the safety of use for the playground, especially for younger children.

TO PREVENT PUBLIC NUISANCE
The people who run the current events at the Rugby club, are probably not aware of how much the sound carries & how loud it is. The occasional private event is manageable, as there is a limit time limit at night. However, the possibility of noisy people and loud music from 8am - 1am is intolerable. ~~See extra page~~

TO PREVENT CRIME & DISORDER

Increased football and increased access to alcohol would inevitably lead to increased unsocial behaviour in the playing fields and by the river. This would also disturb the wildlife, ducks, swans, otters etc.

PUBLIC SAFETY

The only access to the Rugby club is along very narrow roads, with difficult bends and few passing places. I have no idea how event organisers think they could manage large volumes of traffic along this road. It's difficult enough to drive along the Linney on day light, much more hazardous at night, especially with the parking meters sticking out into the road - more traffic - more chance of crashing into them. Another big concern is the river - potential drowning
