THE PREVENTION OF HARM TO CHILDREN

Linney play area is next to the Rugby Club and this is used by many families with young children and many teenagers, often well into the evening in summertime. There is no mention of addressing this risk in the application.

TO PREVENT PUBLIC NUISANCE

Noise from functions travels right across Linney residential area - this is acceptable occasionally for small private functions or sporting events but not 365 days a year and not into the early hours of the morning. Regular large events would also be a nuisance since the roads are unsuitable.

TO PREVENT CRIME & DISORDER

Regular events with alcohol consumption late into the night will encourage crime and disorder in this quiet residential area. The Rugby Club propose ejecting drunk people out of the premises..... which puts them into our Linney residential area and the playground.

PUBLIC SAFETY

The roads/lanes into and through Linney are not suitable for an increase in traffic. Safety issues for residents and the public on foot and in cars already exist. It is narrow, as are the pavements and also poorly lit. Cars often mount the pavements to pass each other & corners.
