
Please add my name to those objecting to this application. The site is in

the Ludlow Conservation Area in a residential area. To have noise and associated disturbance from outside activities late into the night and early hours is inappropriate.

The great value of the Linney is it's quiet and green character. It would not be appropriate to disturb residents, local pedestrians or our wildlife with music at the times applied for.

As well as residents, many people living on the north side of Ludlow walk along Linney to avoid the traffic on Corve St. because they want to walk in a quiet environment where the wildlife is protected.

The application claims to be for new premises but this is untrue; the premises have been in existence for some time.



Generally if there is to be a hearing to determine the premises licence application, the sub-committee will only be able to consider matters that have been previously disclosed. No new evidence can be introduced at the hearing. It is therefore imperative that you detail all matters that you wish to be considered on this initial representation. Please attach additional sheets if necessary.

If you do make a representation you will be expected to attend the Licensing Sub Committee and any subsequent appeal process. All representations in their entirety, including your name and address, will be disclosed to the applicant for the premises licence and any other interested parties. If all parties agree,

the application can be dealt with without holding a hearing.
