

LICENCING RESPONSES

• TO PREVENT PUBLIC NUISANCE

The Rugby Club is located in an area near residential properties, namely, The Linney on the one side of the river and Dinham and Halton Lane on the opposite side of the river.

Organising events outside of the Clubhouse on the surrounding grounds to the early hours of the morning, as proposed in the Licencing Application, will create high levels of noise.

The noise travels not only to the adjacent residential properties but also across the river towards the Whitcliffe affecting all residential and other properties in the vicinity.

This will have a detrimental effect on the people living in the surrounding areas as their quality of life will be affected.

Also, the increase in artificial lighting of the Rugby Grounds can be considered another element of Public Nuisance.

This also will have a detrimental effect on the residential properties of the surrounding areas and moreover, the Nocturnal Wildlife.

The location of the Rugby Club is completely unsuitable for this type of application.
