The applicant is planning to refurbish the inside of 19 WYLE COP to allow the business to operate as a café restaurant 12months of the year. The premises of 19 WYLE COP is currently used as a retail shop selling home and gifts trading as WYLE BLUE WORLD. In recent years the shop has continued trading through, local flooding, COVID, the energy crisis and now entering a global recession. Unfortunately operating a high street shop is no longer a viable business.

It is for this reason the applicant would like to change the use of 19 Wyle Cop from Class A1 retail to Class A3 restaurant/café bar. It is the intention to utilise the premises by opening a restaurant/café bar offering food, wine, and spirits, operating between the hours of 10am – 11:30pm, seven days a week. The applicant would continue to operate the garden under the current conditions, the trading name of the business will be changing from blueBAR to WYLE BLUE restaurant, café bar.

The WYLE BLUE café restaurant will offer an authentic, ambient, up market but affordable dining experience, serving an array of Middle Eastern and Mediterranean inspired, small plates during the winter and utilising the courtyard and terrace garden April – September as per Belinda's current license

In summary the variation falls into several areas:

- To extend the current licensed area to include the inside of 19 Wyle Cop as shown on the plan attached.
- To extend the opening hours of the premises, being inside the property of 19 Wyle Cop to Monday – Sunday 10.00 – 11:30pm.
- The extension of hours for the sale of alcohol within the premises of 19 Wyle Cop to permit such licensing activity daily 10am– 11:00pm

premises closing to the public 30 minutes thereafter. With the conditions for the garden remaining as is under the current license, Monday – Tuesday 12.00– 16.30, Wednesday to Sunday 12.00 – 19.30.

- For the extension of the licensed operation of 19 Wyle Cop, courtyard and Terrace to permit such licensing activity 12months of the year, to coincide with that of our planning permission. With the conditional hours for the courtyard and terrace set out under our planning permission and license to remain the same.

- To amend the restrictive condition under Annex 2, No.9
"Alcohol can only be served with a meal outside, or as an ancillary item before and/or after a meal"

WYLE BLUE will predominantly operate as a café/restaurant, where guests will be seated at reserved tables. The applicant would like the opportunity to reserve a small area within the premises of 19 Wyle cop for non-reserved walkins guests who may choose to just have a drink, this will however remain table service.

- To change to wording under section ANNEX 2, No.5 to read as follows "colour digital CCTV, with picture quality capable of being used for evidence, will be installed with coverage of all internal and external areas used for licensable activities of where seating is provided, all point(s) of sale and all entrances/exits. The CCTV will be operational at all times when the premises is open to the public.
