

Rate of children who ended an episode of need per 10,000 children aged 0-17




Children in Need (CIN) with an open episode of need





Remained in care until aged 18





Care leavers - UASC/Former UASC (16/17 year olds)




Care leavers - UASC/Former UASC (17/18 & 19/20/21 year olds)




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Care leavers pathway plan and contact timescales



Care leavers PA allocation and in touch










(A20) Time between entering care and placement order




(A2) Time between placement order and deciding on a match






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Demographics of children across all areas of children's social care
