Notice of Intention to Conduct Business in Private

Notice is hereby given in accordance with Regulation 5(6) and (7) of the Local Authorities (Executive Arrangements) (Meetings and Access to Information) (England) Regulations 2012 that with the agreement of the appropriate Scrutiny Chairman the following item is likely to be considered in private:

1. Help to Change

The reason that the item is likely to be considered in private is that it will involve the disclosure of exempt information under the following categories of Schedule 12A of the Local Government Act 1972:

(3) Information relating to the financial or business affairs of any particular person (including the authority holding the information).

The reason why the meeting is urgent and consideration of the item above cannot be reasonably deferred is due to the decision being time critical and it is considered that to delay the decision(s) being taken would unacceptably exacerbate the position on the matters referred to above.
