<p><b>THE PREVENTION OF CRIME AND DISORDER</b></p> <p>This is a quiet residential area with many older residents (my mother is 87 and lives alone).          Currently all businesses in the shopping centre are closed by 5:00/5:30pm.          Customers leaving the potential bar venue at midnight or later in an inebriated state will leave residents with flats nearby (especially those at road level as is my mother) open to potential vandalism brought on by drunkenness.          St Mary's square/ St Mary's place/Parade shopping centre is an historic site which may be degraded in the aftermath of drunken behaviour.</p>
<p><b>PUBLIC SAFETY</b></p> <p>Residents would feel unsafe/intimidated if on returning home late at night, they had to confront groups of drunken people .          An evening of alcohol often leads to aggressive behaviour.</p>

**THE PREVENTION OF PUBLIC NUISANCE**

This is a quiet residential area with many older residents (my mother is 87 and lives alone).  
Parking is limited in the vicinity.  
People leaving by car in the early hours will disturb the local residents.  
There is single lane traffic around the square with very limited parking.  
An increase in traffic will affect people trying to access their homes.  
Loud music from 8:00 - 0000 and later will affect local residents quality of life.  
There are many people who sit out in their gardens, balconies or car park areas for some peace and quiet at home


