- A representation can be made against an application for a premise to carry on a licensable activity within the 28 day consultation period. Representations can also be made on premises that are making variations to an existing licence.
- Representations are made by:
 - Responsible authorities
 - Other persons

TO PREVENT PUBLIC NUISANCE

The challenge for Bobby's Bar is its location in the heart of a residential building surrounded by other residential buildings in the centre of Shrewsbury including my own, Watergate Mansions, which is right next door. It is not clear from the licence application how the owners propose to minimize disturbance from the noise of the restaurant, its live music and its patrons, particularly late at night. Potentially hundreds of could be affected by the noise it generates. Having witnessed firsthand the exuberance of late night drinkers in the centre of the town particularly at weekends I need reassurance that the Licensing Committee will take this into account when assessing the application.

All representations in their entirety, including your name and address, will be disclosed to the applicant for the premises licence and any other interested parties. If all parties agree, the application can be dealt with without holding a hearing.
