THE PREVENTION OF CRIME AND DISORDER

I am concerned about the very realistic potential increase of foot traffic (specifically inebriated customers) coming down St. Mary's Water Lane late at night after the bar's closing hours or any time after drinking and eating at the venue. The Blackfriars garage area is in St. Mary's Water Lane. The reason I am so concerned is that there has been quite a bit of trouble there over the last year or so. This trouble involved drugs discarded needles-syringes and empty alcohol bottles, defecating and urinating, and individuals loitering in the area. The Blackfriars garage area is particularly secluded and private which is most likely why it attracts individuals to "hang out". I have a garage there and over the last couple of years I have been fearful to go there as I have seen various individuals (not residents) loitering and as previously stated have seen broken glass bottles, discarded needles, syringes, and human waste in the area. I have contacted Shropshire Council regarding this and there are plenty of emails between myself and Chris Westwood at Shropshire Council on the matter. I have been advised that a CCTV camera will be installed nearby but after almost a year there is still no date for installation. With or without the CCTV, it is still very much a concern. I worry that this may lead to further crime-drugs and anti-social behaviour in the area.

THE PREVENTION OF PUBLIC NUISANCE

Whilst I enjoy music, both live and recorded, I do not want to be disturbed by it to the point that I cannot sleep. I have no objection to recorded music or live music indoors but I do have serious objection to the hours listed on this application and the fact that it may be outdoors.

I emphasize: if the music was only indoors with the doors closed, I would not have any objection at all. If the original times and days as stated in the Temporary Pop Up were adhered to, I would not be so concerned if it was outside either. The hours originally were till 10:00 PM except on Sunday when it was 6:00 PM. However, this new application indicates midnight every night and even 2:00 AM on special days.


I am a light sleeper with a health condition requiring me to get adequate rest and sleep. In fact, lack of sleep sets off episodes which are detrimental to my health. I live close to the venue and any music played outdoors at the Parade car park I can hear as evidenced during a music festival held there last year. It is especially apparent during the summer months when the windows are open. I am aware that quiet hours in the UK are between 11:00 PM and 7:00 AM. The hours on this application are beyond that time.
