THE PREVENTION OF PUBLIC NUISANCE

- 1. The Shrewsbury Town Residents' Association was established in 1991 inter alia to 'represent the interests of residents of Shrewsbury Town Centre living within the river loop, to local and national authorities and other organisations.
- 2. This Representation is an Objection to the Application on the grounds of the Prevention of a prospective Public Nuisance which this Application (if granted) would cause to those residents living within the vicinity of the Premises and particularly in the Court (immediately above the Parade) Watergate Mansions and Upper and Lower Blackfriars Crescent.
- 3. It is noted that part of the Premises is external which will result in virtually no control over significant levels of loud noise in an area which in the evening and at night time is predominately a quiet residential haven.
- 4. The Nuisance will be created by the Noise resulting from Music and other conversational loudness emanating from both within and particularly from the exterior of the Premises at late hours in this residential area.
- 5. This application is totally inappropriate and would seriously jeopardize the Quality of Life of residents living in and close to the same building.
- The Association cannot see any merit in this Application and considers that it is not sustainable in this part of the historic Town Centre of Shrewsbury for the reasons stated above.
