<p><b>THE PREVENTION OF PUBLIC NUISANCE</b></p> <p>1. The Shrewsbury Town Centre Residents' Association was established in 1991. One of its principal Aims is 'to promote a balance between residential, business and visitor interests which maintains the essential character of Shrewsbury and enhances the quality of life of all who live and work here' .</p> <p>2. This Representation is an Objection to the Application for Variation of the Premises Licence to extend the hours of use of the external terrace into the evening hours. This Objection is made on the grounds of the Prevention of a prospective Public Nuisance which this Application (if granted) would undoubtedly cause to those residents living within the vicinity of the Premises and particularly in The Court ( immediately above the Parade) Watergate Mansions and Upper and Lower Blackfriars Crescent.</p> <p>This is also in support of the Objections by those Residents.</p>

3. This Nuisance will be created by the Noise resulting from conversational and other loudness emanating from the external terrace of the Premises in the evening hours in this predominantly residential area. Furthermore the ability to control the levels of such noise would be virtually impossible .

4. This Association made Objection to the original Application made by the Applicant in 2024.....less than two years ago. Nothing has changed since then which in our view invalidates the Conditions which were considered and imposed by the Licensing Committee in July 2024 and referencing the Report by the Council's Officer submitted to the Committee .

5. This Application is wholly inappropriate and would seriously jeopardize the Quality of Life and Amenity of residents living in, above and close to the site of the Terrace of the Licensed Premises.

6. The Association cannot see any merit in this Application and considers that it is not sustainable in this specific part of the historic Town Centre of Shrewsbury for the reasons stated above.

7. The proposed extension would cause Public Nuisance contrary to the Licensing Objectives and there is no credible reason for seeking to vary the existing Conditions.
