

**NOTICE OF PUBLIC PATH ORDER AND DEFINITIVE MAP
AND STATEMENT MODIFICATION ORDER**

**HIGHWAYS ACT 1980
WILDLIFE AND COUNTRYSIDE ACT 1981**

**THE SHROPSHIRE COUNCIL (FOOTPATH 72 (PARTS), PARISH OF LONGDEN)
PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION ORDER 2018**

The above named order made on 6th December 2018 by the Shropshire Council (“the Council”) under section 119 of the Highways Act 1980, will **divert**

the full width of that part of Footpath 72 Longden from point A (SJ 4574 0571) on the order map, running in a general south westerly direction to pass through a gate at point D (SJ 4570 0567) on the order map and then continuing in a general west-south-westerly direction across a field to point E (SJ 4552 0558), a distance of approximately 265 metres; **and** the full width of that part of Footpath 72 Longden from point D (SJ 4570 0567) on the order map running in a general southerly direction across a field to point B (SJ 4568 0556) on the order map, a distance of approximately 115; a total distance of approximately 380 metres; **onto a line** from point B (SJ 4568 0556) on the order map, running in a general north easterly direction following a field edge path then crossing the field boundary via a pedestrian gate (SJ 4571 0559) to continue in a general north easterly direction along the field boundary then running in a general easterly and then north easterly direction across the field to a pedestrian gate at point C (SJ 4578 0564) on the order map where it meets Bridleway UN2 on chapel Lane, a distance of approximately 138 metres; **and** that part of Footpath 72 Longden from point E (SJ4552 0558) on the order map running in a general south easterly direction across a field to point F (SJ 4565 0550) at a junction with the continuation of Footpath 72, a distance of approximately 157 metres. The sections of footpath 72 to be created are a total distance of approximately 295 metres with a width of 2 metres throughout.

A copy of the order and the order map and an explanatory statement have been placed and may be seen free of charge at the Council offices at The Shirehall, Abbey Foregate, Shrewsbury during normal office hours or via the Council’s website at www.shropshire.gov.uk/outdoor-recreation/countryside-access-and-public-rights-of-way/current-public-path-orders. Copies of the order and map may be bought from the Council, at the above address at a cost of £6.50.

Any representations about or objections to the order may be sent in writing to Shropshire Outdoor Partnerships, Rights of Way Mapping and Enforcement Manager, The Shirehall, Abbey Foregate, Shrewsbury, SY2 6ND, or by email to outdoor.recreation@shropshire.gov.uk, not later than 7th January 2019. Please state the grounds on which they are made.

If no such representations or objections are duly made, or if any so made are withdrawn, the Council may confirm the order as an unopposed order. If the order is sent to the Secretary of State for the Environment, Food and Rural Affairs for confirmation any representations and objections which have not been withdrawn will be sent with the order.
