All In Short Breaks are leisure activities, specifically commissioned for children with disabilities by Shropshire Council. They are part of the council's Early Help Offer.

To be eligible for All In Short Breaks, children must live in Shropshire, be aged under 18 and have a disability that prevents them from joining mainstream leisure activities. The All In programme is delivered by a number of providers across the county.

Please note that if you are a carer for a looked after child, placed by another Local Authority in Shropshire, the child will not be eligible for All In Short Breaks. However, the other Local Authority can contact providers directly to commission an additional service from them.

The current programme runs until 31 August 2020.

This form needs to be completed to ensure your child is eligible and registered to take part in any 'All In' Short Break activities. All In activity providers will ask for your registration number, before you can take part. They may also need more information about your child to ensure that the activity is tailored to your child's needs.

By mainstream leisure activities, we mean activities which are available to all children. For example: after school clubs, sport activities, youth clubs.

It also allows us to keep in touch with families about the All In programme.

We keep this information in a 'children with disabilities register'. The information is protected by the Data Protection Act. This means that information is stored safely and will not be shared with third parties, unless you give us consent to do so. Once your child reaches their 18th birthday, they will be removed from the register.
