

**NOTICE OF CONFIRMATION AND COMING INTO OPERATION OF  
PUBLIC PATH ORDER AND DEFINITIVE MAP  
AND STATEMENT MODIFICATION ORDER**

**HIGHWAYS ACT 1980  
WILDLIFE AND COUNTRYSIDE ACT 1981**

**THE SHROPSHIRE COUNCIL (FOOTPATH 6 (PART),  
PARISH OF CORELEY) PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION ORDER 2019**

On 13<sup>th</sup> March 2020, The Shropshire Council (the "Council") confirmed the above named order made under section 119 of the Highways Act 1980 and section 53A(2) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981. The effect of the order as confirmed is to **divert**

the full width of that part of Footpath 6 from point A on the order map (SO 6132 7494), running in a general north-north-easterly direction across a field to meet the County Road at point B on the order map (SO 6139 7506); a distance of approximately 138 metres; **onto a line** from point C on the order map (SO 6133 7483), running in a general easterly then north-north-easterly direction across a field following the line of a hedged field boundary to meet the County Road via a pedestrian gate at point D on the order map (SO 6144 7498); a total distance of approximately 196 metres with a width of 2 metres throughout.

A copy of the order as confirmed and the order map have been placed and may be seen free of charge at The Shirehall, Abbey Foregate, Shrewsbury during normal office hours or via the Council's website at <https://shropshire.gov.uk/outdoor-partnerships/countryside-access-and-public-rights-of-way/current-public-path-orders/>. Copies of the order and map may be bought from the Council at the above address at the price of £6.50.

Shropshire Council certify that the order becomes operative on 13<sup>th</sup> March 2020; but if a person aggrieved by the order wants to question its validity, or that of any provision contained in it, on the ground that it is not within the powers of the Highways Act 1980, as amended, or on the ground that any requirement of the Act, as amended, or any regulation made under the Act has not been complied with in relation to the order, he or she may, under paragraph 2 of Schedule 2 to the Act as applied by paragraph 5 of Schedule 6 to the Act, within 6 weeks from 13<sup>th</sup> March 2020 make an application to the High Court.
