Partner Requirements:

The void process is an important operation to our business, and any partners, contractors and suppliers who are involved in the process of void refurbishment must be able to demonstrate high standards of service

Potential energy partners must be able to meet the following key requirements:-

- Have a proven track record in switching energy supplies during a landlords void period.
- Be able to provide a simple administration process
- Be able to offer a debt clearing service.
- Provide free of charge void energy for landlord use.
- Be able to offer excellent tariffs for both pre-paid and credit meters.
- Provide a dedicated account manager.
- Provide energy advice and innovation.
