

All about me @ 2: Communication activities

Activities to play with your child together, to support their development.

Example activity	Example image
Ask your child to cover their ears. Hide a loudly ticking clock or a softly playing radio in a room and let your child find it. Take turns by letting him / her hide and you find the object.	
Use plastic animals or stuffed animals to tell the story of 'Old McDonald had a farm'. Use sound effects to enliven the song and story!	
Sing other action rhymes together e.g. 'Incy Wincy spider', 'I'm a little teapot', 'If you're happy and you know it'. Change the words using your child's name.	
Play the 'show me' game when looking at books. Ask your toddler to find an object in a picture. Take turns. Let your toddler ask you to find an object in the picture. Let him / her turn the pages.
