

## **All about me @ 2: Communication activities**

Activities to play with your child together, to support their development.

<b>Example activity</b>	<b>Example image</b>
<p>Ask your child to cover their ears. Hide a loudly ticking clock or a softly playing radio in a room and let your child find it. Take turns by letting him / her hide and you find the object.</p>	
<p>Use plastic animals or stuffed animals to tell the story of 'Old McDonald had a farm'. Use sound effects to enliven the song and story!</p>	
<p>Sing other action rhymes together e.g. 'Incy Wincy spider', 'I'm a little teapot', 'If you're happy and you know it'. Change the words using your child's name.</p>	
<p>Play the 'show me' game when looking at books. Ask your toddler to find an object in a picture. Take turns. Let your toddler ask you to find an object in the picture. Let him / her turn the pages.</p>
