Children's Activities and Events Volunteer

Supporting and delivering variety of children activities and events in libraries.



What would I be doing? Am I right for this opportunity?	 You would: help to organise and/or deliver children's activities such as story time, Rhyme Time and craft activities; talk to children and their parents about children's activities; gather feedback and promote library events. Ideally you will have: some experience of engaging with children and young people; a confident, outgoing personality; good communication skills; an interest in books, libraries and reading; creativity and enthusiasm.
What will I get from volunteering?	 You will gain: valuable training and experience that can be included in CVs and job applications; the opportunity to meet others in the local community.
When can I do my volunteering?	There are a variety of opportunities throughout the year. Enquire at your local branch for details.
Where will I be volunteering?	You would normally be able to volunteer in a library or virtually using digital devices.
Who will be there with me?	Library staff and other activity and event volunteers.
Support and review	Regular support and guidance will be given by a named library contact. There will be an agreed trial period to ensure that all is going well – another volunteer role may be suggested if the trial period has shown that this would be better for both parties.
Training, resources and information	A full induction will be given, and further training offered where appropriate.



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
