Shropshire Council has powered down

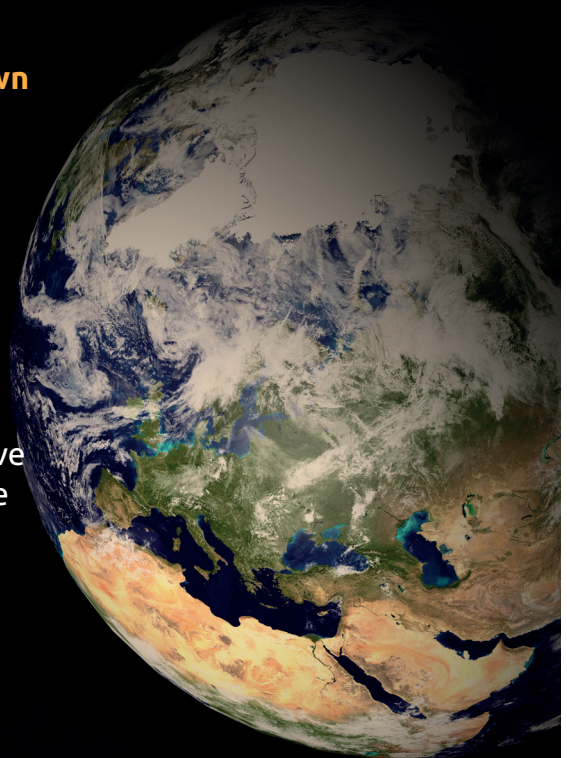
- by improving energy efficiency and reducing carbon emissions from buildings and transport

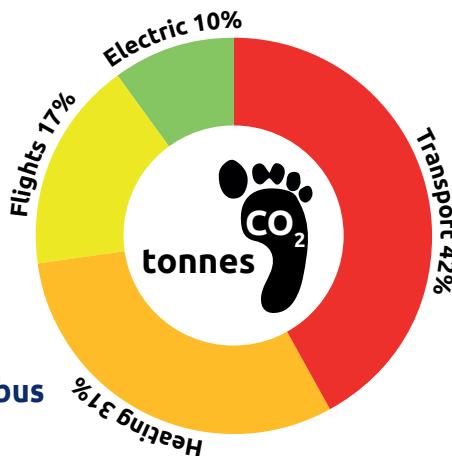
Accept the challenge!

This is the carbon breakdown for the average Shropshire household:

This is what we can all do:

- **Drive a less polluting car –**
share car journeys
- **Better still walk, cycle, or take the bus**
- **Avoid air travel**
- **Make your home more energy efficient (*)**
 - make sure your loft is well insulated
 - use low energy appliances and LED light bulbs
 - don't leave appliances on standby
 - turn down the heating by a degree or two
- **Use less – repair more often – and recycle**
- **Waste less food –** eat more fruit and veg from Shropshire farmers
- **Look after the natural world – plant trees – let hedgerows grow – and encourage wildlife**
- **Buy your electricity from a renewable energy supplier**

Average Shropshire Household (2019) = 8.48 CO₂
