

**NOTICE OF PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION AND
DEFINITIVE MAP AND STATEMENT MODIFICATION ORDER
HIGHWAYS ACT 1980
WILDLIFE AND COUNTRYSIDE ACT 1981
THE SHROPSHIRE COUNCIL (BW 277 (PART) PARISH OF RUSHBURY
PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION ORDER 2023.**

The above named order made on 22nd June 2023 by the Shropshire Council (“the Council”) under section 119 of the Highways Act 1980 and section 53A(2) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981, will divert

The full width of that part of Bridleway 277 running from point A on the Order Map at grid reference SO 5151 9170 in a general NNW then north easterly direction over a yard area, then on a natural surface to point B on the Order Map at grid reference SO 5153 9174. A distance of approximately 69 metres **onto a line** leaving point A on the Order Map at grid reference SO 5151 9170 running in a general easterly direction on a natural surface, turning in a general north westerly direction, through a gate at grid reference SO 5156 9171 and continuing in a general north westerly direction on a natural surface to a second gate at grid reference SO 5153 9174 to re-join the Definitive Line of BW 277 at point B on the Order Map at grid reference SO 5153 9175. A distance of approximately 107 metres with a width of 3 metres throughout its length.

THIS REPLACES THE ORIGINAL DIVERSION ORDER MADE ON THE 26TH JANUARY 2023.

If the order is sent to the Secretary of State for the Environment, Food and Rural Affairs for confirmation any representations and objections which have not been withdrawn will be sent with the order.
