

**NOTICE OF PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION AND
DEFINITIVE MAP AND STATEMENT MODIFICATION ORDER**

**HIGHWAYS ACT 1980
WILDLIFE AND COUNTRYSIDE ACT 1981**

**THE SHROPSHIRE COUNCIL (FOOTPATH 1B (PART), PARISH OF LONGDEN)
PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION ORDER 2023**

The above named order made on 7th September 2023, by the Shropshire Council (“the Council”) under section 119 of the Highways Act 1980 and section 53A(2) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981, will;

divert the full width of the part of Footpath 1B from point A on the Order Map grid reference SJ 4526 0783 where it leaves the County Road, running in a general south easterly direction across the access and garden of No 2 The Hazels for approximately 40m to a stile where it meets the continuation of Footpath 1B at Point C on the Order Map grid reference SJ 4528 0779 **onto a line** from Point B on the Order Map grid reference SJ 4528 0784, where it leaves the County Road, a footpath will be created running in a general SSE direction along a surfaced access track with a width of 2.5 metres then turning to run in a general SSW direction along a grass track between boundaries with a width of 3 metres to a stile at Point C on the Order Map grid reference SJ 4528 0779 where it meets the continuation of footpath 1B. The route has a total distance of approximately 48m.

Please state the grounds on which they are made.

If no such representations or objections are duly made, or if any so made are withdrawn, the Council may confirm the order as an unopposed order. If the order is sent to the Secretary of State for the Environment, Food and Rural Affairs for confirmation any representations and objections which have not been withdrawn will be sent with the order.
