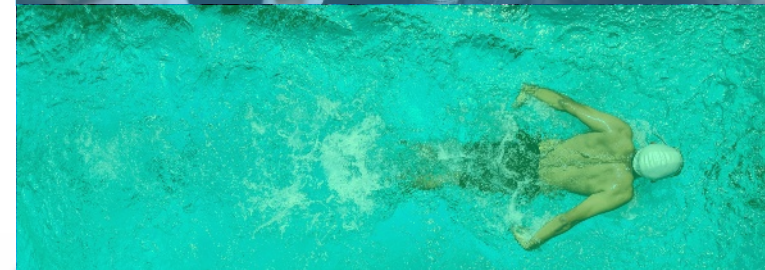

What is Social Prescribing?

Social Prescribing is similar to a prescription for medicine but is a non-clinical approach. It supports people to access community services to help improve their health and well being.

Patients meet with a trained Healthy Lives Advisor, who will signpost to community groups, such as yours, and support the patient as they are referred to activities.

What are the benefits of becoming an accredited Social Prescribing provider?

- Free publicity for your activities via our networks & Shropshire Local Directory
- Your services can be more widely available to those who can benefit from accessing it
- Networking with other social prescribing providers
- Follow up and support for referred patients by the Healthy Lives Advisor

What happens if my group wants to become an accredited Social Prescribing offer?

Contact your local Community Development Officer who will arrange to discuss the process and support available. This will include how a referral takes place and guidance through some simple paperwork. If you need any further advice you can receive help from the Shropshire Infrastructure Partnership team.

Once your group is signed up to become an accredited social prescription you will have access to the Community Connectors Network across Shropshire and feature on the Shropshire Directory of services, where you can show case your offering.

You will then begin to receive referrals through the Healthy Lives Advisors as people are signposted to your services.
