## NOTICE OF CONFIRMATION & COMING INTO OPERATION OF PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION AND DEFINITIVE MAP AND STATEMENT MODIFICATION ORDER HIGHWAYS ACT 1980 WILDLIFE AND COUNTRYSIDE ACT 1981

- 1. THE SHROPSHIRE COUNCIL (FP 1 (PART) & FP 11 PARISH OF WEM RURAL & FP 3A (PART) PARISH OF PREES) PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION ORDER 2024.
- 2. THE SHROPSHIRE COUNCIL (BW 98 (PART) PARISH OF WEM RURAL) PUBLIC PATH EXTINGUISHMENT ORDER 2024.

On 18<sup>th</sup> April 2024, The Shropshire Council (the "Council") confirmed the above named order made under section 119 & 118 of the Highways Act 1980 and section 53A(2) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981.

The effect of the order as confirmed is to

- 1. **Divert** the full width of FP 1, FP 11 & FP 3A leaving FP 10 at point A on the Order map at grid reference SJ 5375 3173 running as FP 1 in a general NNE direction on a natural surface, through the buildings, then continuing as FP 11 through the yard of Upper Lacon Farm then in a general easterly direction on a natural surface to the Parish boundary as FP 3A to point B on the Order map at grid reference SJ 5437 3191. An approximate distance of 771 metres **onto a line** leaving FP 10 at point A on the Order map at grid reference SJ 5375 3173, FP 1 ascends steps and passes through a gate then runs in a general WNW, northerly, NNE then easterly direction on a natural surface to a gate, crossing the stoned access drive and continuing as FP 11 to a second gate, both gates are located at grid reference SJ 5397 3213. From here the footpath continues in a general easterly the southerly direction on a natural surface to the Parish Boundary and to point B on the Order map at grid reference SJ 5437 3191. A total distance of approximately 1212 metres with a width of 2 metres throughout.
- Extinguish the full width of BW 98 leaving FP 1/11 at point A on the Order map at grid
  reference SJ 5389 3197 running in a general NNE direction over the stoned yard then along
  the stoned access track to point B on the Order map at grid reference SJ 5396 3214. A total
  distance of approximately 185
  metres.

Shropshire Council certify that the order became operative on 11<sup>th</sup> April 2024 but if a person aggrieved by the order wants to question its validity, or that of any provision contained in it, on the ground that it is not within the powers of the Highways Act 1980, as amended, or on the ground that any requirement of the Act, as amended, or any regulation made under the Act has not been complied with in relation to the order, he or she may, under paragraph 2 of Schedule 2 to the Act as applied by paragraph 5 of Schedule 6 to the Act, within 6 weeks from 18<sup>th</sup> April 2024 make an application to the High Court.
