I am impressed with the amount of care given to the preparation of the Draft Local Plan, and, in this case, in particular to the balancing of housing needs with the protection of open space and Green Belt areas. This is shown by the designation of just two sites for future development at ALB017 and ALB021.

If permission were to be granted for extensive development on areas P36A and P36B I am concerned that the present lovely character of the Albrighton and Boningale areas would be destroyed.
