I have lived in the centre of Albrighton for ______. My parents moved here from _____ and one of the primary reasons for moving was how green the village was. My dad drove here for the first time and came off the ____ and knew this was the place to bring his family up. Some of the things that I love about living in Albrighton is the sense of community, its local services and the fact that we can easily access public footpaths that cross green land (some of this is greenbelt).

The Local Plan is an important document that I fully support as it is vital that any development is sustainable, in proportion, does not stress local services and does not negatively impact greenbelt or the wider environment when there are brownfield sites that could be considered for development.

- Shropshire Local Plan Additional Sustainability Appraisal Report. Response to various sections Having reviewed the contents of the draft Local Plan I think that Shropshire Council's proposed sites
 (Tasley, Shrewsbury and Ironbridge Power Station) for development (to meet the Black Country
 Housing needs) are by far the most suitable
- Table 12.4 I can see that Albrighton has allocated sites for housing which I believe are sustainable. Given the proposed sites listed in 12.3 I believe that no other sites should be listed in Albrighton and certainly no further sites on any surrounding greenbelt. I am not against further housing being built in Albrighton, but it needs to be in proportion to the services of the village and needs to protect the green space around Albrighton once this precious resource is lost it will never be regained. An Open Space Strategy was completed in 2004 and it assessed the quality of open spaces throughout the Bridgnorth District. The results showed that there is a lack of good quality open space in Albrighton since then we have lost some of our greenbelt land to housing (currently sustainable) but we must not lose anymore.
- Additional Sustainability Appraisal Report Appendix 3 Updated Stage 3 Site Assessment. It is
 interesting to note that the draft Local Plan has already assessed the sites P36A and P36B as not
 suitable, that are currently being discussed by Boningale Homes as a 'sustainable and progressive'
 development on Albrighton greenbelt. In view of the above and the importance of retaining
 greenbelt wherever possible these sites should not be considered for development by anybody.
