	My family have lived in Albrighton for over
years	and I am delighted to have an opportunity to
submit my views as part of the consultation period.	

Albrighton is a typical British village in an unspoilt rural setting, with a good balance of amenities and a lovely village feel and community spirit. We have beautiful greenbelt surrounding the village and we often have walks along the small back roads and enjoy the outlook of green fields. My house is surrounded by fields and is in greenbelt and I have aspired and worked hard to live in the village. All of the above factors improve well-being and health of residents and community groups that visit. **Strategic Policy P6 Page 29**

I have read through the Shropshire Local Plan and I fully support it because it has been thoroughly developed by the planning team with many considerations and continual in-depth reviews given to many wide-ranging issues. **Updated Greenbelt Topic Paper para 5.1 to 5.15**.

In particular, I am delighted that it supports and maintains the protection of precious Greenbelt and maintains the projected and sustainable village population. Overdevelopment in Albrighton would massively stretch the infrastructure and amenities. There is in my mind, a real danger that villages could be destroyed by overdevelopment and this plan has thoroughly reviewed future housing needs in Albrighton and the wider Shropshire County, and it is reassuring that the detailed reviews of all aspects will ensure that housing needs are met in Shropshire and Albrighton until 2038 and the future years beyond that. **Housing and Employment Topic Paper Paragraphs 8.7 and 8.8**

I feel that the planning team and council have engaged with communities, and thoroughly reviewed the current and future housing needs including 1500 homes from the Black County and West Midlands. It was encouraging to see confirmation that more suitable sites than Albrighton exist in Shropshire (Eg the Old Ironbridge Power Station) site have been identified as being suitable to meet these needs. These sites are mainly or in part Brownfield and negate the need for permanent and harmful damage to Greenbelt. **Updated Greenbelt Topic Paper paras 6.13 to 6.15**.

There has already been large housing development planned and part delivered at the Millfields estate in Albrighton. I was extremely relived that the plan fully assessed the Albrighton South sites P36A and P36B and concluded that these sites are not appropriate for development. Additional Sustainability Appraisal Report Appendix 3; Updated Stage 3 Site Assessment. Any development on this site would cause a huge sprawl of the village. At the same time, it would completely split the village in two, destroy a huge element of Greenbelt and farming land, as well as causing chaos with traffic through the village and small estate roads. This would also hugely increase CO2 emissions in the village and around existing housing estates and countryside. SP6 Point 8. I fully agree with and know by talking to many residents that development on this site would be totally out of kilter and not cohesive with the village and it's amenities. Updated Greenbelt Topic Paper paras 6.3 and 6.4 and Additional Sustainability Appraisal Report Appendix 3; Updated Stage 3 Site Assessment.

The Greenbelt, the size and scale of the village, the rural feel will be maintained along with the beautiful aspects of nature that exist in the fields that surround the village. Many which have precious farming land and environmentally important factors – all of which have been carefully considered in this plan. I find the Shropshire Local plan to be sound with clear and comprehensive supporting information and documents.
