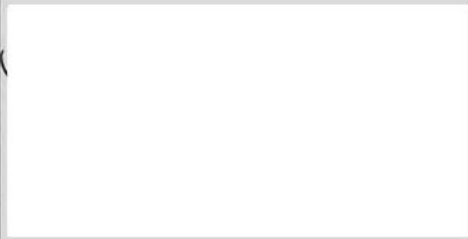
Having lived in the Black Country for all of my life, there are so many areas that are crying out for investment and development.
