Adderley, Morton Say and Norton in Hales Neighbourhood Plan – Decision Statement

Decision Statement published pursuant to the Localism Act 2011 Schedule 38A (9) and Regulation 19 of the Neighbourhood Planning (General) Regulations 2012

Shropshire Council decided at a meeting of its full Council on the 26th September 2024 to 'make' the Adderley, Morton Say and Norton in Hales Neighbourhood Plan under Section 38A(4) of the Planning and Compulsory purchase Act 2004. The Adderley, Morton Say and Norton in Hales Neighbourhood Plan now forms part of the Development Plan for Shropshire.

Decision and reason

"DECIDED: That Shropshire Council, as the Local Planning Authority 'makes' (i.e. adopts) the Adderley, Morton Say and Norton in Hales Neighbourhood Plan and brings it into force with immediate effect as part of the Development Plan under the Planning and Compulsory Purchase Act 2004.

Reasons for the Decision

The Neighbourhood Plan meets the basic conditions and its preparation process is compliant with legal and procedural requirements. Paragraph 38A(4)(a) of the Planning and Compulsory Purchase Act 2004 requires the Council to make the Neighbourhood Plan if more than half of those voting in the referendum upon the plan have voted in favour of the plan being used to help decide planning applications in the area. The plan was endorsed by more than the required threshold in the referendum held on 25th July 2024.
